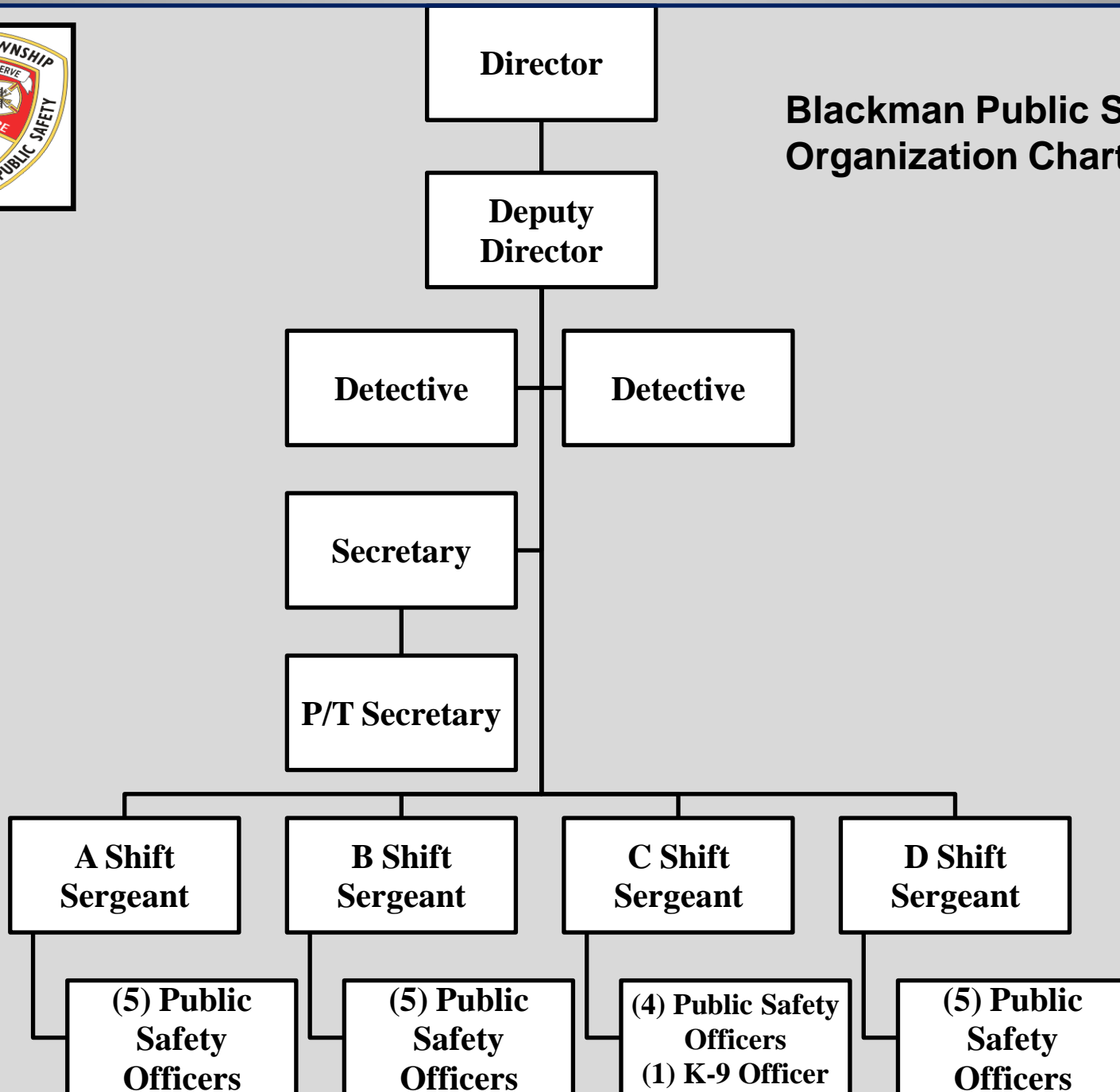




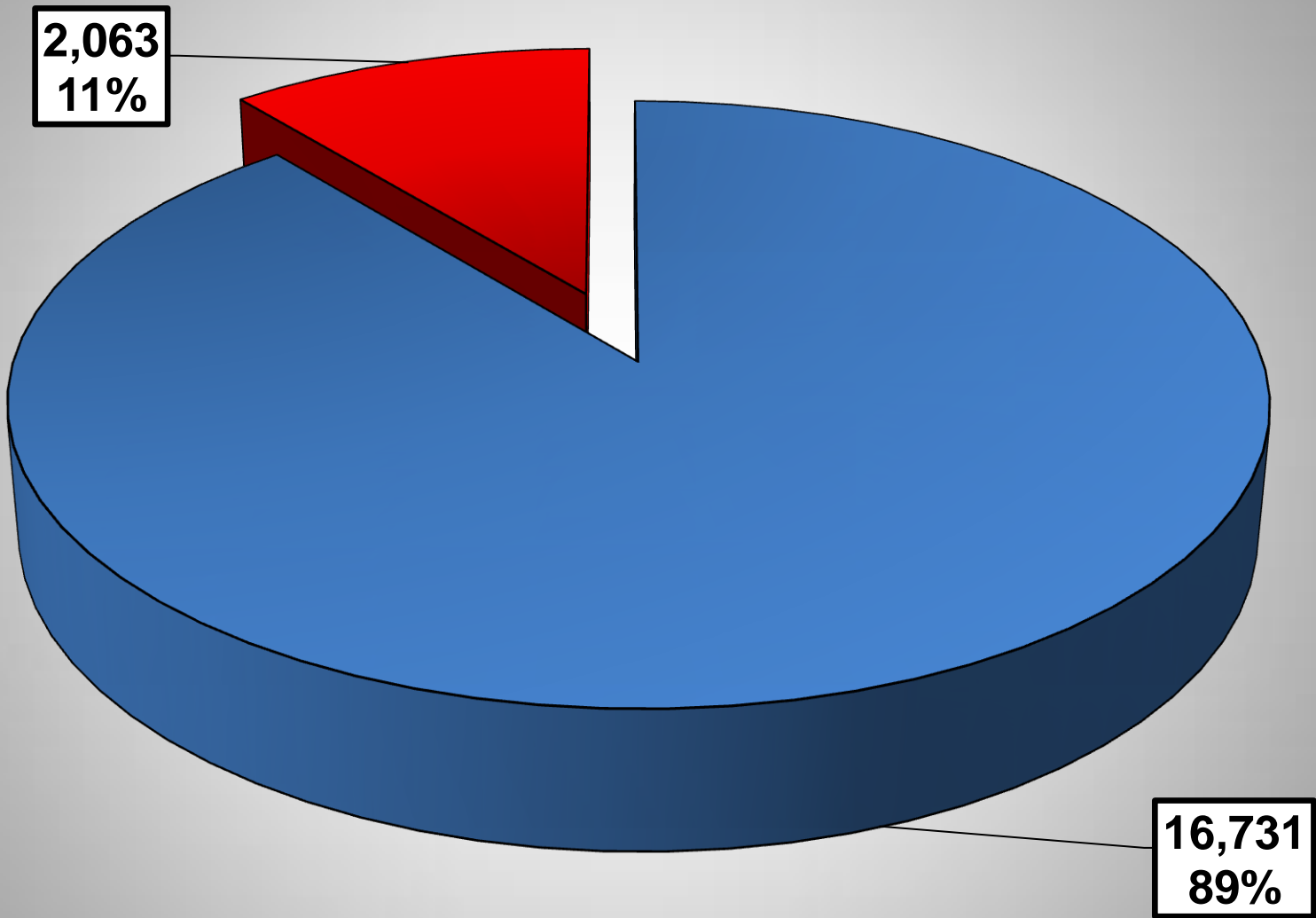

Blackman Public Safety Organization Chart

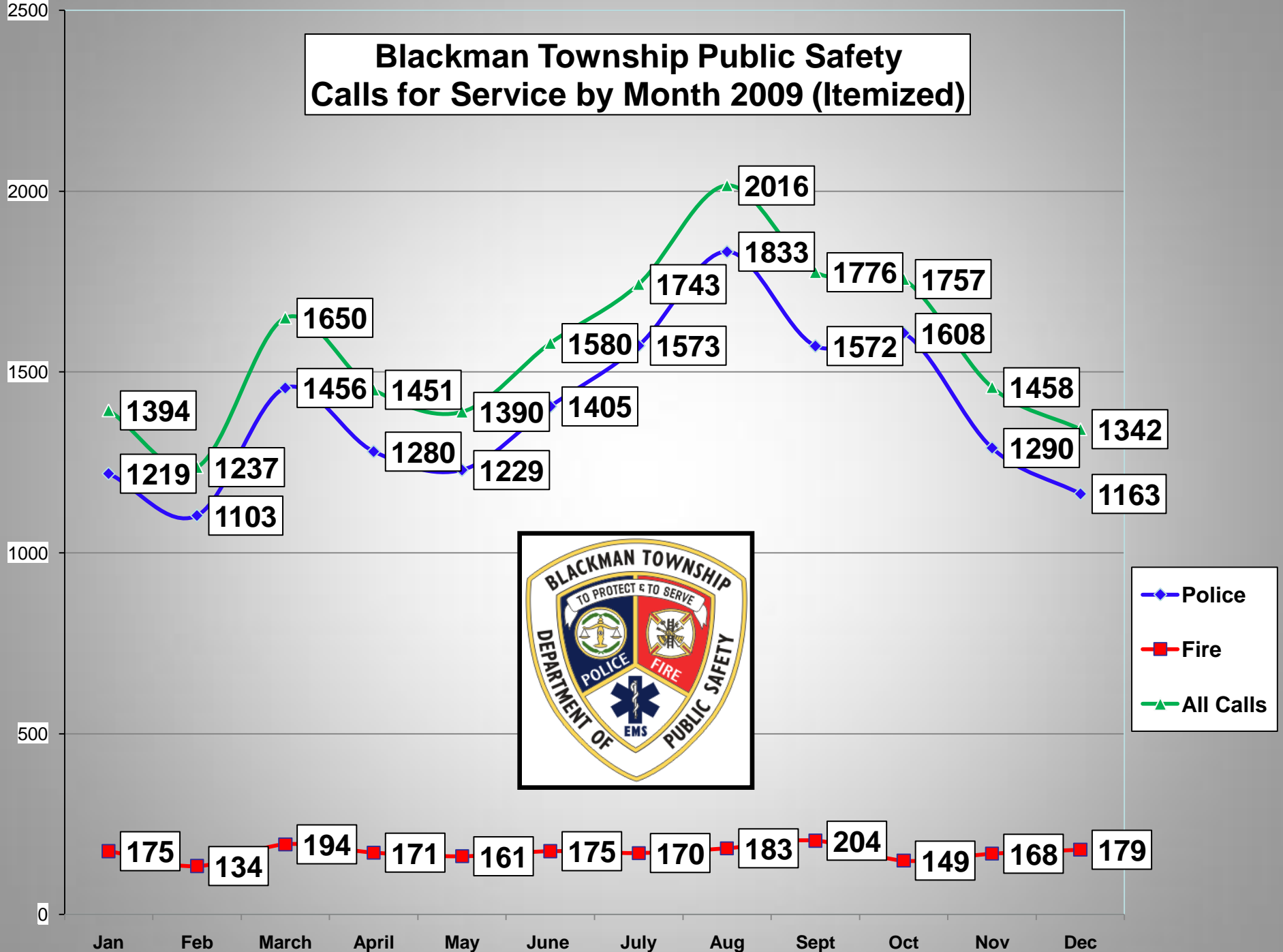

- **30.8 % Increase over Last Ten Years**

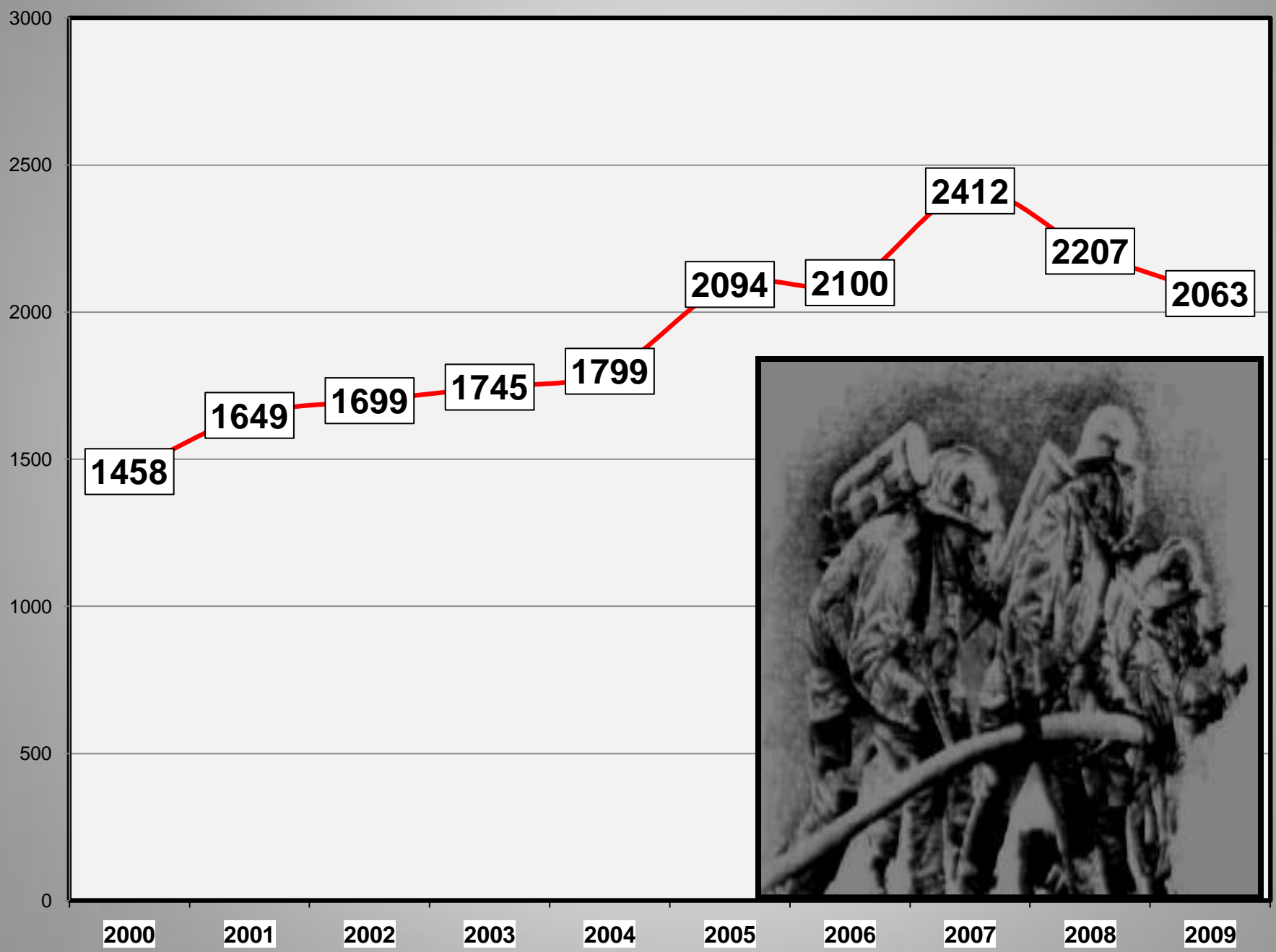

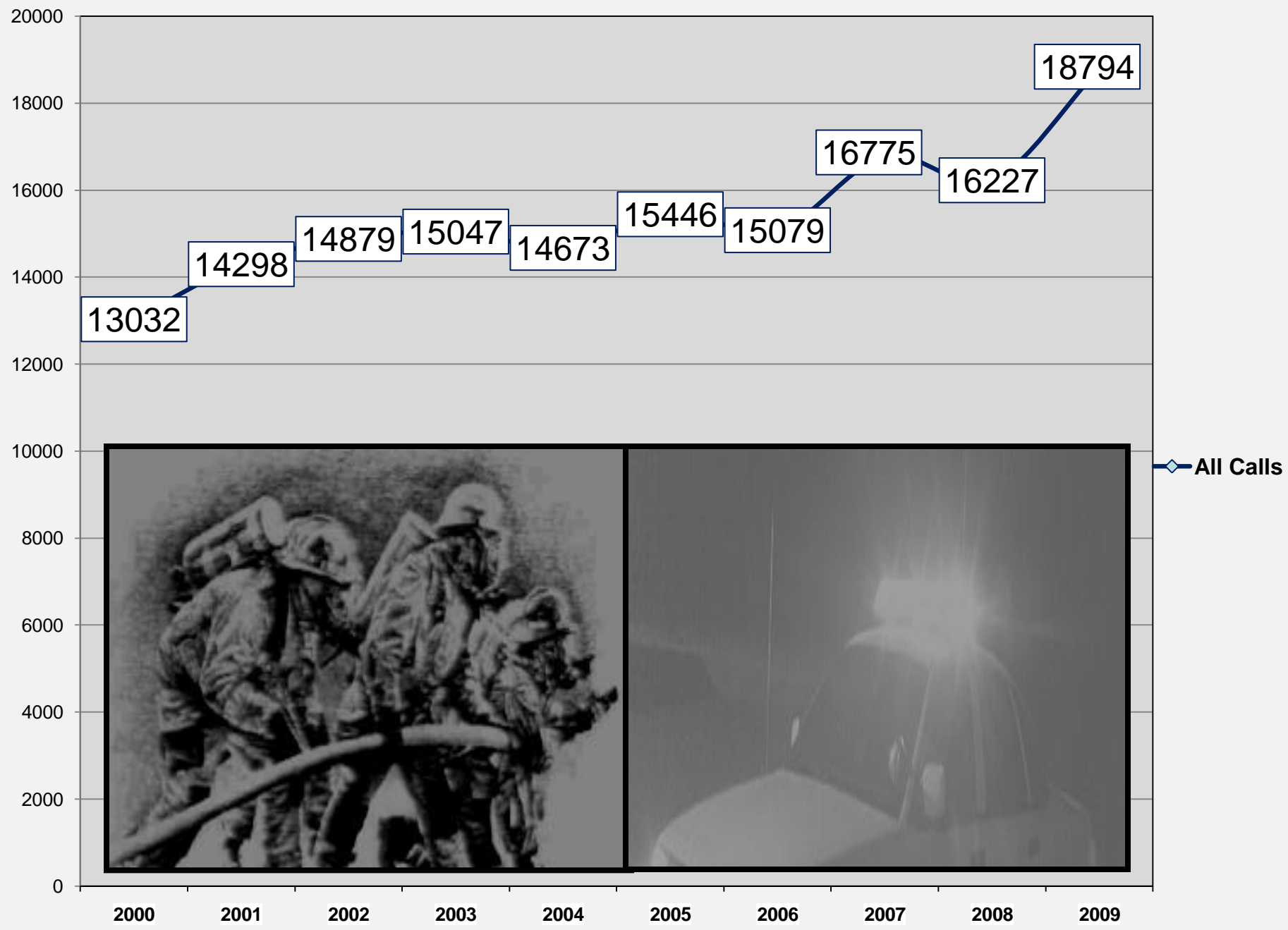




BTPS: Fire Calls

Fire Prevention Efforts



Education:

The department provides fire safety training to elementary and preschool-aged children, senior citizen complexes, as well as to other businesses upon request



Enforcement:

The department conducts fire inspections at the more than 500 township business and commercial occupancies

Crime Prevention Efforts



This department had 163 drug cases and 113 OWI arrests last year



This department executed 30 search warrants on residences and completed 57 separate forfeitures



Many of these self-initiated activities were led by the department's detectives and K-9 officer positions

Inter-Agency Cooperation

- **Automatic Mutual Aid Response**
 - **City** **71 structure fires**
 - **Summit** **30 structure fires**
 - **Blackman** **32 structure fires**

 - **Blackman provided 113 man hours**
 - **Blackman received 276 man hours**

Grant-Funded Coverage

- Blackman Public Safety performed approximately 625 hours of extra coverage focusing on drunk driving and seat belt enforcement with over **\$29,000** worth of federal and local **traffic grants**
- Blackman Public Safety received **\$20,000** in federal funding from a **personnel grant** with Homeland Security
